Charges and Regulations at South Petherton Parish Council

For the Exclusive Right of Burial in an earthen grave, 9ft by 4ft (single)	200.00	Double
For the Exclusive Right of Burial in an earthen grave, 9ft by 4ft (double)	400.00	Double
For the right to construct and for the Exclusive Right of Burial in a walled grave or vault, 9ft by 4ft (single)	300.00	Double
For the Exclusive Right of Burial in one plot Reserved for cremated remains within the Memorial Wall area (all single plots)	100.00	Double

Child up to the age of 18	No Cost	No Cost
Adult aged 18 years and over	100.00	Double
Burial of cremated remains	80.00	Double

Monuments, Gravestones, Tablets and Monumental Inscriptions

For the right to erect or place on a grave or vault in respect of which the Exclusive Right of Burial (EROB) has been granted – the holder of the EROB is the only person who can apply for these.

Memorials on burial plots must not be erected for a least six months (12 months preferable) or until the ground has settled. Cremation plots can be completed immediately.
Cemetery Rules & Regulations in respect of memorials, installations & decorative items/ornaments are to be followed, or risk being removed.

Flat stone not exceeding 9ft by 4ft	200.00
Headstone not exceeding 5ft in height	100.00
Footstone	60.00
Kerbstones or border stones enclosing a space not exceeding 8ft by 3ft	200.00
Erection of memorial plaque on the wall	80.00
Vase	40.00
Erection of a wooden cross	100.00
Installation of a seat – limited in number	100.00

Written permission MUST be obtained from the Clerk to erect a headstone and/or carry out alterations to existing headstones.
